RE: Coastal Zone Consistency for Lake Washington Ship Canal – Shell Hash Removal from the Small Lock Project, Lake Washington Ship Canal, Seattle, King County, Washington

Dear Mr. Lewis:

On October 1, 2015, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Seattle District (Corps) submitted a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP), for the Lake Washington Ship Canal—Shell Hash Removal from the Small Lock project. On November 18, 2015, the Corps and Ecology agreed to extend the CZM until May 30, 2016.

The proposal entails removal of up to 300 cubic yards of shell hash from the small lock in order to restore passage through the navigation channel and allow for closure of the work gates. The material would be placed on site onto riprap along the opposite (south) side of the small lock wall.

The project is located at Hiram M. Chittenden Locks, 3015 NW 54<sup>th</sup> Street, Seattle, King County, Washington, Lake Washington Ship Canal, Sections 10 and 11, T. 25 N., R. 3E., WRIA 8.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with the Corps' determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC govern the appeal process. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).



To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
