On May 6, 2010, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued you a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (Certification) for the Battle Ground Medical Emergency Center.

In a June 12, 2015 email, you stated that to date nothing is planned for this site. In addition, the Corps permit for this project expired on July 26, 2013. For these reasons, Ecology is officially **rescinding** the Certification Order #7335 dated May 6, 2010.

If you decide to proceed with your project in the future, you must reapply for a 401 Certification at that time if your project requires a Corps permit.
