Dear Mr. Sloan:

On July 6, 2010, the Port of Seattle submitted a Federal Consistency Determination stating that the proposed Terminal 5 Maintenance Dredging Program, which include three phases of dredging at Berths 1, 2, and 3 (6,410 cy in the first year, 4,000 cy in the second year, and periodic maintenance of shoals of undetermined volumes in years three through ten) and potential removal and replacement of up to five fender piles that may be damaged during each dredging event is consistent with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP). Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) concurs with the determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

You have the right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board. To appeal this you must:

- File your appeal with the Pollution Control Hearings Board within 30 days of the "date of receipt" of this document. Filing means actual receipt by the Board during regular office hours.
- Serve your appeal on the Department of Ecology within 30 days of the "date of receipt" of this document. Service may be accomplished by any of the procedures identified in WAC 371-08-305(10). "Date of receipt" is defined at RCW 43.21B.001(2).

Be sure to do the following:

- Include a copy of this document that you are appealing with your Notice of Appeal.



- Serve and file your appeal in paper form; **electronic copies are not accepted.**
