

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The project proposes to move two existing points of diversion from their authorized locations related to the Masterson and Seaton ditches, downstream on the Teanaway River, to a single location on the applicant's property. The new point of diversion is a pump which withdraws directly from the stream. The same diversion will serve two water rights held by the applicant, S4-85116-J and S4-83748-J. The applicant has applied to the Conservancy Board to change the PODs for both rights under KITT-14-09 and KITT-15-06 respectively. The new point of diversion was constructed under WDFW HPA#105777-2, with installation of a metering device as specified under Kittitas County Conservation District cost-share agreement #C-061. The change will be modified with provisions to protect intervening water rights.
