IRRIGATION METHOD:	

<p>CONSUMPTIVE USE CALCULATION:</p> <p>Indoor use: Four residential connections at 350 gallons per day (gpd) used continuously year round equates to 1.568 afy of water use. Consistent with WAC 173-539A-050(3), 30% of domestic in-house use on a septic system is consumptively used, therefore: Indoor consumptive use = 0.470 afy</p> <p>Outdoor use: The requestor proposes to irrigate 2000 ft² of lawn and garden. Using a crop irrigation requirement of 18.11 in/yr (or 1.51 ft/yr) for pasture/turf near Cle Elum from the Washington Irrigation Guide and an application efficiency of 80%, the total outdoor irrigation water use is 0.087 afy. Consistent with WAC 173-539A-050(3), 90% of outdoor use is consumptively used, so: Outdoor consumptive use = 0.078 afy CU for the project totals to 0.548 afy (CU April 1 to August 31 is 0.260 ac-ft and CU Sept 1 to March 31 is 0.288 ac-ft)</p>

<p>NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:</p> <p>The requestor proposes to offset the 0.548 afy of consumptive use for the project (Four residential connections and 2000 ft² of lawn and garden) with 0.548 afy of mitigation</p>
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water acquired from Trust Water Right No. S4-05259CTCL@2sb7. During the irrigation season, 0.288 ac-ft is assigned to the USBR-Ecology Exchange Contract (Contract No. 09XX101700) and released between September 1 and March 31 to address out-of-season impacts along the Yakima River. The parcels are located in Suncadia's "yellow area."

Review of the local area hydrogeology suggests that the proposed groundwater withdrawals under G4-35770 may result in flow impacts to the Yakima River.

Location Map for G4-35770




Figure 1: Location of the POU for the G4-35770 WBN request.
