IRRIGATION METHOD:	

<p>CONSUMPTIVE USE CALCULATION:</p> <p>Indoor use: 1 residential connection at 350 gallons per day (gpd) used continuously year round equates to 0.392 ac-ft/yr of water use, or: Consistent with WAC 173-539A-050(3), 30% of domestic in-house use on a septic system is consumptively used, therefore: Indoor consumptive use (CU) = 0.118 ac-ft/yr</p> <p>Outdoor use: The requestor proposes to irrigate 500 ft² of lawn and/or garden. Using a crop irrigation requirement of 18.10 in/yr (or 1.51 ft/yr) for pasture/turf near Cle Elum from the Washington Irrigation Guide and an application efficiency of 80%, the total outdoor irrigation water use is 0.022 ac-ft/yr. Consistent with WAC 173-539A-050(3), 90% of outdoor use is consumptively used, so: Outdoor consumptive use = 0.019 ac-ft/yr</p> <p>Consumptive use for the project totals to 0.137 ac-ft/yr (CU for the period of April 1 to August 31 is 0.065 ac-ft and CU for the period September 1 to March 31 is 0.072 ac-ft)</p>

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The requestor proposes to offset the 0.137 ac-ft/yr of consumptive use for the project (1 residential connection and 500 ft² of lawn and garden) with 0.137 ac-ft/yr of mitigation water acquired from Trust Water Right No. CS4-01467@11sb3a(A). 0.072 ac-ft is assigned to the USBR-Ecology Exchange Contract (Contract No. 09XX101700) to address impacts along the Yakima River.

The proposed well is to be located in parcel 949675. The proposed well for the new use is to be located in an area that needed additional information (“yellow area”) to determine the suitability of the Masterson Ranch Trust Water Rights for use as mitigation to offset the new use. Review of the local area hydrogeology suggests that the requested withdrawals would result in impacts to Lodge Creek west of Kachess Lake.
