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
NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:  The project proposes to fallow four acres of irrigated pasture and put a proportional amount of the water right into instream flow. Fortysix or the original 50 acres will
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remain irrigated on the place of use. The total quantity of water left instream is 11.32 acre-ft, of which 6.79 acre-ft is used consumptively. The 6.79 acre-ft. consumptive use water will be entered into the State Trust Water Program for water banking through a process separate from this change of water right.

# Fallowed Land

Revised April 2016

Starting at the south-west corner of the property line along Reecer Creek Road an area for which the boundaries are generally described as follows: Approximately 375 feet due east, then approximately 475 feet due north, then approximately 375 feet due west to the western boundary line of the property and back to the point of beginning.
