

On May 29, 2012, the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued a 401 Water Quality Certification to the City of Bellevue for the above-referenced project pursuant to the provisions of 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401).

Ecology received a request from the Applicant on March 6, 2014, requesting a change to Condition D1 to extend the authorization in order to complete the project.

Administrative Order No. 9216 dated May 29, 2014, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Condition D2 that reads:

This Order will expire on April 19, 2014.

Is replaced with:

This Order will expire on March 18, 2018.

No other conditions or requirements of the above-mentioned order are affected by this amendment. The Department of Ecology retains continuing jurisdiction to make modifications hereto through supplemental order, if it appears necessary to further protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this amended Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this amended Order.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
