Subject: Stormwater for New SIC

Quick Questions:

For the proposed ISGP, I have a client who is existing facility and will need to permit due to their site being added in SIC list (Existing Facility Not Under Permit Coverage). I'm confused in terms of what the application states versus what the permit states:

1. **Submit application** – in permit it states (S2.3.a.iv), “existing facilities shall submit an application for coverage within 30 days of notification by Ecology that coverage is required. – I'm not sure what that means – do they wait to hear from Ecology, or should they plan on submitting an application within XX days after the general permit becomes final (some time this spring)?
2. **Submittal of SWPPP** – the permit states (S2.3.a.iii) “the SWPPP to Ecology with the application coverage” The application states an existing facility has 30 days to submit the SWPPP after receipt of permit.

So my questions are: for an existing facility that now has to have coverage, when do they submit the application? When do they submit the SWPPP? Do they need to be in compliance the day the General Permit is final or is it when Ecology issues a permit to the site?
