The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge the Department of Ecology (Ecology) has accepted your request to donate a portion of Groundwater Certificate G1-25160C into the Washington State Trust Water Right Program. The subject trust water right has been assigned control number CG1-25160C. Please refer to this number when corresponding with us about this trust water right.

Source: 2 wells within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W. M. (Through a Showing of Compliance, there is now just one (new) well within the same location.)

Instantaneous Rate: 130 gallons per minute (gpm)

Annual Volume: 44 acre-feet per year (afy)

Purpose of Use: Irrigation – during irrigation season

Place of Use: That portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the center of said Section: thence along the west line of said subdivision north 00° 12'30" west, 456.28 feet to the north line of Bonneville Transmission Line Easements (total width of easements equal 375.00 feet); thence along said north line north 69°00'16" east, 700.00 feet; thence north 28°27'28" east, 686.21 feet; thence north 89°14'14" east, 350.00 feet; thence south 00°12'40" east, 347.67 feet to the north line of said Bonneville easements; thence along said north line north 69°00'16" east, 1233.89 feet; thence south 00°12'50" east 401.10 feet to the south line of said Bonneville easements; thence along said south line south 69°00'16" west,

1139.56 feet; thence south 33°07'02" west, 699.76 feet to the south line of said subdivision; thence along said south line south 89°13'39" west, 1037.44 feet to the True Point of Beginning; containing 35.84 acres.

Application Information

On April 9, 2015, Ecology received your request to donate a portion of the subject right to the trust program. According to the information supplied with your request, the full certificated instantaneous rate and annual volume have been put to beneficial use within the past 5 years. The most recent beneficial use of water was in November 2014. Elk Run Golf Course closed for business at that time. You indicated on the donation form you are the owner of the entire right.

Your intent for placing a portion of the subject water right into trust is to protect that portion from relinquishment while a determination is made on the subsequent use of the property and associated water right, and to provide for groundwater preservation.

Your Requested Terms for Temporary Donation

1. You requested to donate an instantaneous rate of 90 gpm (of the certificated 130 gpm) into temporary trust for groundwater preservation purposes.
2. You requested to retain the right to use up to 40 gpm for on-site authorized uses.
3. You requested to donate an annual volume of 43 afy (of the certificated 44 afy) into temporary trust for groundwater preservation purposes.
4. You requested to retain an annual volume of 1 afy for on-site authorized uses.
5. You requested a donation period through April 1, 2035.
6. You requested the ability to withdraw the temporary donation from trust by providing a 72 hour written notice to Ecology.

Ecology's Acceptance

The Department of Ecology pursuant to RCW 90.42.080(1)(b) accepts your temporary donation of **90 gpm and 43 afy for groundwater preservation**. As per your request, **this temporary donation will expire on April 1, 2035**. If, prior to the expiration of this temporary donation, you would like to extend or revoke the donation, or modify its terms, please send us a written request. **If you decide to withdraw your donation from the trust program, please provide Ecology with a 72 hour written notice.**

Ecology's acceptance of the donated water right into the trust water right program is not evidence of the extent, validity, or quantities of the water right.

In accordance with RCW 90.42.040(6), RCW 90.14.140(h), and RCW 90.14.215, a water right is not subject to relinquishment while it is managed within the Trust Water Right Program.

Your Right To Appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of the Order.

File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.

- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.
- You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
