Re: Acceptance for Temporary Donation of Ground Water Certificate 928-D
For the Dairy Portion of the Quantity

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge Ecology's acceptance of your temporary donation to the Washington State Trust Water Right Program. The trust water right has been assigned the control number 4702169 for the above certificate. Please refer to this number when corresponding with us about your trust water right.

The Department of Ecology, pursuant to amended RCW 90.42.080(1)(b), through **2009 Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5583**, acknowledges your donations detailed as following:

Ground Water Certificate No. 928-D
Water Right Certificated Quantity: 750 gallons per minute; 200 acre-feet per year
Accepted Donation Quantity: **6.7 acre-feet/yr for the dairy portion of use**
Purpose of donation: Ground water reservation
Duration of donation: **from October 31, 2010 to October 31, 2012**

The Ground Water Certificate 928-D authorized the point of withdrawal for the irrigation of 37.5 acres, domestic use and dairy purpose of use. The recorded point of withdrawal is located: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 19 N., Range 27 E.W.M. However, the actual point of withdrawal for the dairy purpose of use was changed to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Township 19 N., Range 28 E.W.M., in the 1970s in order to comply with the Department of Health inspection recommendation.

Amended RCW 90.42.080 provides in part that the total of any portion of the water right remaining with the donor plus the donated portion of the water right may not exceed the extent to which the water right was exercised during the five years before the donation.

In accordance with amended RCW 90.42.040(6), RCW 90.14.140(h), and RCW 90.14.215, a water right is not subject to relinquishment while it is managed within the Trust Water Right Program.





Ecology's acceptance of the donated water right into the trust water right program is not evidence of the validity or quantity of the right. When the period of trust ends, the water right will revert back to the water right holder or landowner in the full quantity accepted into the trust water program and for the original purposes.

If, prior to expiration of this temporary donation, you would like to extend the period of donation, or modify any terms of your donation, you need to submit your request in writing. Ecology will review your request for change and will notify you whether the terms or the period of donation can be extended.
