DRIVING:

South bound on I-5: Take Martin Way exit 109, turn left onto Martin Way, at the second Martin Way traffic light turn right onto Desmond Drive.

North bound on I-5: Take Martin Way exit 109, turn right onto Martin Way, at the second traffic light turn right onto Desmond Drive.

We encourage you to carpool or use transit; parking at Ecology is limited.

Intercity Transit Routes 62A and 62B stop on Martin Way, in front of the Ecology building.

VISITOR PARKING:

From Martin Way, head up Desmond Drive. At the intersection, turn left and proceed along the front of the Ecology Headquarters building, past a stop sign at the main entrance. The main Visitor parking lot (1) is on the left. If full, you can find additional visitor parking (2) along the road to the right, just past the parking garage.

If the all visitor spaces are full, continue on to the outdoor employee parking lot behind the parking garage (3) and park in any empty space that is not marked as “reserved” (numbered parking spots are OK).

Overflow parking: If no spaces are available in the first three parking options, then exit back along front of building, but instead of returning to Martin Way, turn left at Desmond Dr and follow the small road (red curved line below) towards the U.S. Fish and Wildlife offices in Sawyer Hall. As you approach those buildings, turn off to the right and proceed to the parking lot **behind** the building (4). You may park in any spot except as specifically marked. Then take the walking trail back to the Ecology Building and enter at the main entrance.
