DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal

“The Beyond Waste Plan 2009 Update” is the title of the combined State Solid Waste and State Hazardous Waste Plans. The 2009 Plan Update continues the 30-year vision (year 2035) set by the original 2004 Plan for the management of solid and hazardous waste in Washington. The Department of Ecology will review the plan regularly and update the plan every five years.

Proponent

Department of Ecology Waste 2 Resources and Hazardous Waste & Toxic Reduction Programs

Location of proposal, including street address, if any

The “Beyond Waste Plan 2009 Update” applies to the entire state of Washington. The plan is not required, but sets direction for: Ecology and other appropriate state agency staff; local governments as they update and implement their local solid and hazardous waste plans; businesses, especially regulated hazardous waste generators; pertinent non-government organizations; and other interested parties. The implementation section of the “2009 Beyond Waste Plan Update” has more details on actions and activities for Ecology, local governments, and others.

Lead agency

Department of Ecology
