2009 Actions Under Consideration

EE/GB Action 1: Energy Efficiency Incentives:

- Energy Efficiency Quality Investment Program (EEQUIP)
- CHP and Distributed Energy Development

EE/GB Action 2: Energy Efficiency in Existing, New and Renovated Public Buildings

EE/GB Action 3: 2009 State Energy Code Improvements and Continuous Energy Efficiency Improvement Program for Buildings

EE/GB Action 1A: Energy Efficiency Quality Investment Program (EEQUIP)

Revised Elements:

- Additional text for tax incentives for residential buildings meeting energy efficiency targets
 - Sales tax incentives
 - Property tax incentives
- Revised text for sales tax incentives for non-residential buildings
- Revised text/criteria for Public Utility Tax Incentives in non-residential/multi-family residential sectors
- Revised text to allow government entities to provide funding for energy efficiency improvements based on state bonding authority

Quantification of 2009 Actions and Recommendations

Review of quantification procedures proposed by facilitators for IWG feedback (see memo)

- Common assumptions across IWGs
- Suggestions as to data sources, methods, assumptions by Action
 - Need IWG input on key sources of information
- Suggestion to provide quantitative analysis only for CHP/Distributed Energy element of Action 1, as building energy efficiency incentive elements largely support Actions 2 and 3
 - EE/GB Co-lead suggests that it may be important to quantify building EE aspects of Action 1 as well

Preparation for September CAT Meeting

- Small groups revise 2009 Actions based on input from co-leads and full IWG. Submit revised text to facilitators and co-leads by COB Thursday, Sept. 11
- Based on feedback from this meeting, facilitators, working with IWG members and others as available, begin process of quantitative analysis of Actions
 - Partial results possible by CAT meeting

Next Steps

- Working with co-leads and facilitators, small groups continue to refine actions as needed based on full IWG input in preparation of materials for Sept. 18-19 CAT meeting
- Working with small groups, co-leads, and others as identified by IWG members to identify relevant data sources, facilitators will continue quantification of 2009 actions in preparation of the next IWG meeting on Sept. 24
