Is it actionable? (Near-term= couple yrs; Medium = 5 years; Long-term = 5 + years)	Is funding needed? (\$100Ks, \$1 Ms, \$10 Ms)	Is legislation needed? (State? Local? Both?)	Does this increase flexibility to prepare/adapt?	Fit with other gov't priorities/programs for "bang for buck" or political support?	How important is this relative to other actions on the list? (Low, Medium, High)
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Category 1: Enhance institutional capacity to prepare/adapt to impacts of SLR

Category 2: Increase capacity of natural ecosystem to adapt to impacts of SLR

Category 3: Increase capacity/resilience of coastal infrastructure to handle impacts of SLR

Planning Actions (from WR PAWG)

- 26. Incorporate climate change into comprehensive plans under GMA (locals).
- 27. Comment on comprehensive plans to address climate change/water issues (agencies).
- 28. Provide technical assistance with SMAs, State Wildlife Management Plans, SEPA (agencies).
- 29. Strengthen emergency management plans to include greater risks.

Outreach Actions (from WR PAWG)

- 30. Engage the public to raise awareness about climate change.
- 31. Engage watershed/salmon planning groups to consider climate change.
