Identifying Priorities for Analysis

- TWG reviews and revises catalog of options (today)
- CAT reviews, amends, and approves catalog (June 5)
- TWG identifies a preliminary set of priority options for further analysis by voting process (via email, week of June 11-15)
 - Ballot sent by CCS to TWG members,
 - Each TWG member identifies a number of priority options, adds comments as needed (for example, with regard to possible consolidation of policies, rationale for priorities, etc.)
 - If helpful, CCS team can suggest preliminary indicators of potential GHG reductions and costs/cost savings cost (week of May 28-June 1 to enable TWG member comment)
- CCS compiles results for discussion at next TWG call (week of June 18-22)

- Updated based on TWG input

Senate Bill 6001

- *Mitigating the Impacts of Climate Change*
- Put climate goals into statute
- Includes a GHG performance standard for electrical utilities
 - Allows for sequestration of emissions to meet standards
 - Requires Department of Ecology to write rules for the standard and for sequestration
 - Requires Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council to evaluate the sequestration plans for facilities under its jurisdiction
- Other bill provisions that relate to Energy Supply TWG are noted in Description of Catalog Items
