- Forestry high priority options affirmed by CAT
- CAT feedback:
  - F1 or F3 – TWG should consider an urban forestry component
  - F4 and F7 – when framing implementation mechanisms consider barriers to use of low C substitutes and product labeling with C content
- Additional CAT meeting scheduled on Sept. 4
  - Review and approval of straw proposals
