Purpose: This rule making amends Chapter 173-334 WAC, Children's Safe Products - Reporting Rule to add tris (1,3-dichloro-2-propyl) phosphate (TDCPP) (CAS # 13674-87-8) to the reporting list of chemicals, and to remove n-butanol (CAS # 71-36-3) from the reporting list of chemicals. This rule making is in response to new information associated with petitions to the agency. The Washington Department of Health has also confirmed that TDCPP meets the toxicity and exposure criteria to be included on the CHCC list.
