

## **SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1039**

*Allowing the department of ecology to issue opinions for a portion of a facility under the model toxics control act*

### **PROGRAM IMPACTS**

This bill would authorize Ecology to issue a no further action (NFA) opinion letter for a portion of a site, provided the opinion provides the status of the facility as a whole.

### **RESOURCE IMPACTS**

Ecology is in the process of finalizing guidance on issuance of no further action opinions. That guidance addresses issuing opinions for a part of a site. When appropriate, “no further action” opinions will be issued for parts of individual sites under Ecology’s Voluntary Cleanup Program. Applicants are charged for review time under this program. Resources to conduct these reviews and issue these opinions are part of Ecology’s base funding. No additional resource impacts are anticipated as a result of this bill.
