Report of Transfer of Mercury Tradable Units



Coal-burning power plants in Washington State must report to Ecology the transfer of tradable unit(s) of emissions from one plant to another. The buyer must send this report to Ecology no later than March 1 of the calendar year after the reporting period. If this application is incorrect or incomplete, it will be denied.

Tradable unit – One ounce of mercury emissions. A unit is allocated by Ecology and is valid for the calendar year for which it is issued.

Buyer – Account gaining tradable units.

Seller – Account losing tradable units.
