**RE: Coastal Zone Consistency for Lord Hill Levee Repair 2016 Project,  
Snohomish River, near Snohomish, Snohomish County, Washington**

Dear Mr. Lewis:

On June 16, 2016, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Seattle District (Corps) submitted a Consistency Determination with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for repair of the Lord Hill Levee.

The proposal entails repairs of a levee at 4753'58.06"N, 1225'27.68"W: Specifically, the project would rework the 2015 repaired tie-in and 120 feet of 2015 repairs, as well as an additional 140 feet of bank, for a total construction length of 250 linear feet. The proposal also includes reinstallation of 2015 mitigation plantings.

The project is located on the Snohomish River at its confluence with the Pilchuck River, near the City of Snohomish, Snohomish County, Washington, Section 19, T. 28 N., R. 6E., WRIA 7.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with the Corps' determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:



- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
