This amendment is to the above-referenced Administrative Order approved and issued by the Department of Ecology (Ecology) on March 23, 2009.

This amendment is issued under the provisions of Chapter 90.48 RCW and Chapter 173-201A WAC.

Administrative Order #6503 is hereby amended as follows:

**1. Condition E1 that reads:**

E1. This Order expires five (5) years from the date of issuance. A new 401 Certification must be obtained prior to expiration in order to continue drainage maintenance in Skagit County Consolidated Diking District #22 beyond five years.

**Is replaced with:**

E1. This Order expires November 16, 2014. A new 401 Certification must be obtained prior to expiration in order to continue drainage maintenance in Skagit County Consolidated Diking District #22.

No other conditions or requirements of the above-mentioned Order are affected by this Amendment. The Department of Ecology retains continuing jurisdiction to make modifications hereto through supplemental order, if it appears necessary to further protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this amendment may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this amendment.

## YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do both of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
