Dear Mr. Brandt:

On February 29, 2016, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory submitted a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) to the Department of Ecology (Ecology) for the project referenced above.

The project proposes to conduct in-water research to test marine energy technologies over a five-year period. The proposed research activities include: installation of scientific equipment on the seabed; installation of floating platforms or moored buoys; installation of scientific equipment on the Battelle Marine Science Laboratory (MSL) Pier; and, survey and sediment sampling.

Research activities will be conducted at three specific locations: one at the MSL Pier, and two other locations within Sequim Bay. Up to 25 deployments of scientific equipment and cables will occur within the five-year period, with no more than eight cables and eight scientific measuring devices deployed per year across all three locations.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Pacific Northwest National Laboratory's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.



You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
