RE: Coastal Zone Consistency for Regional General Permit 6, Structures in Inland Marine Waters of Washington State

Dear Ms. Legge:

On January 28, 2016, the US Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) submitted a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for Regional General Permit 6 (RGP 6). On March 22, 2016 the Corps and Ecology agreed to extend the review period until June 21, 2016. On June 20, 2016 the Corps and Ecology agreed to another extension until September 19, 2016.

The proposed RGP 6 authorizes the construction of new overwater residential structures in inland marine waters in Washington State. These structures include piers, ramps, floats, mooring buoys, marine rails, open-frame stairways, bluff-to-beach trams, and watercraft lifts.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with the Corps' determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.



- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
