NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR 5 YEAR LEASE UNDER
TOUCHET RIVER ADJUDICATED CERTIFICATE #350 (TRAC 350)

TAKE NOTICE:

That Scott and Cathy Plucker, through Washington Water Trust of Seattle, Washington has submitted an application for a 5 year lease to place a portion of TRAC No. 350 into the State Trust Water Right Program. This application is being considered for priority processing under WAC 173-152-050(3)(a). Leasing this adjudicated surface water right will benefit flows in the Touchet River, a tributary of the Walla Walla River and will provide improved habitat conditions for fish and other aquatic species.

That TRAC No. 350 authorizes the diversion of 0.923 cubic feet per second (cfs) from April 1st to September 15th and 1.2 cfs from September 15th to April 1st, for the irrigation of 46.2 acres; from a point of diversion on the Touchet River located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 8N., Range 33E.W.M, for a maximum quantity of 107.2 acre-feet per year.

All within, Walla Walla County, Washington, Water Resource Inventory Area WRIA-32
