

## **What is a Clean Unit?**

A clean unit is an emission unit that has not been issued a major New Source Review (NSR) permit before March 3, 2003, and has installed Best Available Control Technology (BACT) or Lowest Achievable Control Technology (LAER). A clean unit designation is valid for 10 years and relieves the source from major New Source Review for changes that will not increase actual emissions.

Clean unit designations are not available at this time. The federal Clean Unit regulations were vacated by the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit on June 24, 2005.
