Approval of Yahoo!'s Third Tier Petition

Ecology has completed its evaluation of health risks from diesel engine exhaust particulate (DEEP) and nitrogen dioxide emissions from the proposed expansion of Yahoo! Data Center in Quincy, Washington.

Ecology's evaluation indicates that the proposed expansion could result in an increased cancer risk for residents living in the vicinity of Yahoo!'s property of up to 4 per million, and a cumulative cancer risk from DEEP exposure of 25 per million. We have determined that the potential cancer risks from the project are acceptable, according to the guidelines found in Chapter 173-460 WAC. Additionally, acute and chronic exposure to particulate diesel emissions and nitrogen dioxide from the proposed project is not likely to result in significant adverse non-cancer health effects.

Therefore, on the basis of the enclosed technical evaluation, I approve the third tier petition. I recommend approval of the proposed project conditioned on the incorporation of the findings into Ecology's final decision on the Notice of Construction application.

Under state regulations, Ecology and Yahoo! must hold a public hearing to present the results of the third tier review process. Please initiate the public comment period on the Notice of Construction application and schedule the public hearing.
