I scanned it quickly, and it looks like it contains

1. good descriptions of the unit control devices.
2. the stack test data covers questions about sulfur emissions being greater than estimated due to primary sludge being burned. As mentioned in the report this depends on the assumption that a representative quantity of sludge was being burned during the testing period. I think this does answer my questions, and appreciate your thorough responses. This project has made me personally curious about the actual contents of primary and secondary sludges, but developing that information will have to be one of my future efforts.

I will be writing a draft order in a few days that will be proposed to implement the BART decisions. In the case of PTPC, since no new controls are proposed, the order will just reference existing permit conditions in your consolidated order from the Industrial Section in a general way, and not duplicate any numerical limits or monitoring conditions. The purpose is to use this order to confirm that PTPC fulfilled its BART requirements.
