



## Notice of Opportunity for Public Comment

### Proposed Amendment to Air Emissions Permit for Puget Sound Energy, Fredonia Power Generating Station

#### Which project is proposed for amendment?

Puget Sound Energy (PSE) was issued Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Permit (PSD-11-05) on October 24, 2013, to expand the Fredonia Generating Station (FGS). FGS is located at 13085 Ball Road near Mount Vernon, Washington. The expansion project will provide up to approximately 181–207 megawatts of additional generating capacity to meet future PSE system needs. The new simple cycle combustion turbines will fire natural gas as the primary fuel. The limited backup fuel is ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel oil.

#### What is Ecology proposing to do?

Ecology has prepared a PSD permit amendment to provide PSE with an 18-month extension to begin construction.
