Re: 60-Day Consultation on Proposed Revision to BART Order for BP Cherry Point Refinery

Ladies and Gentlemen:

You are receiving this as the representative of a Federal Land Manager or a neighboring state that has consulted with Ecology on Washington's Regional Haze State Implementation Plan (RH-SIP). Ecology is proposing a revision to the BART Order issued to the BP Cherry Point Refinery for inclusion in the RH-SIP. This letter constitutes the start of the mandatory 60-day consultation period with the Federal Land Managers.

On May 5, 2014, BP Cherry Point Refinery requested specific revisions to the emission limitations for two subject to BART emission units and additional minor changes. Ecology has reviewed the request and has developed a support document discussing the request and our proposed action to address the request. The net effect of the emission changes is a decrease of 10.4 tons of NO_x per year.

Ecology is proposing to revise the Order included in the RH-SIP in the following ways:

- Allow an increase in the NO_x emissions from one subject to BART process heater.
- Offset that increase by a decrease in the emissions in another subject to BART process heater.
- Incorporate a new condition addressing BART emission limitations when a specific subject to BART emission unit is decommissioned.
- Incorporate a new condition to allow for updating of monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements in the BART Order by regulatory order.

The revised Order will be submitted to EPA as an amendment to the Washington RH-SIP. Any comments or concerns expressed by you on behalf of your agency will be included in the documents related adoption of the proposed revision into the SIP.

After this consultation is complete, we will hold a public comment period and hearing on both the revision to the BART Order and its submission to EPA for inclusion in the Washington RH-SIP.
