## **Geographically focused efforts**

Increased Generator Contact visits – over 1000 since 2001

Spokane Aquifer visits – over 200 businesses visited



## **Current Programs**

**Local Source Control Partnerships** – \$2.5 million to be used by local governments in Puget Sound area counties and the Spokane River watershed to help small businesses control, reduce or eliminate sources of toxic pollution.

**Urban Waters Initiative** – special emphasis on small businesses on the Duwamish River, Commencement Bay and the Spokane River

**Environmental Results Program** – special emphasis on auto body repair shops in the Puget Sound area and Spokane River watershed

**EnviroStars Cooperative** – working with local governments to enhance business certification program
