Description of proposal The Washington State Department of Ecology is proposing to issue an agree order for soil and ground water characterization and potential remediation at the Fuel Processors Site, 701 Bozarth Ave., Woodland WA 98674. Site investigation activities are scheduled to begin in the latter part of 2008. If contamination is found, remediation of the site would begin in 2010. _____
