DRAFT CONSENT DECREE AND CLEANUP ACTION PLAN
AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC REVIEW
B. S. B. DIVERSIFIED COMPANY, INC.

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites the public to read and comment on draft consent decree and cleanup action plan for the B. S. B. Diversified Company, Inc. (BSB), located in Kent, Washington at 8202 South 200th Street.

A Consent Decree (CD) is a legal agreement between BSB and Ecology to ensure an environmental cleanup meets the requirements of the state's cleanup law (WAC Chapter 173-340). The Cleanup Action Plan (CAP), which is being implemented under the CD, describes the proposed cleanup actions and the work to be performed at the site.

Ecology seeks the public's comments on the draft CD and CAP between ***April 18 and May 19, 2008***. Ecology will review public comments in making a final decision. To be considered, comments must be postmarked or received, by email or hand delivery, by ***May 19, 2008***.

If ten (10) or more people request a public hearing, Ecology will conduct a public hearing. *To request a hearing*, or to request special accommodation for the hearing if it is held, contact Hideo Fujita by phone, letter, or email by ***May 19, 2008***. If fewer than 10 people request a public hearing, then a hearing will not be held. To find out if a public hearing will be held and/or its date and location, contact Hideo Fujita after ***May 19, 2008***.

Ecology will consider and respond to all written comments and any comments or public testimony received during a public hearing, if held. After considering the comments, Ecology will make a final decision or a new tentative decision on the draft consent decree and cleanup action plan.
