DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal

An interim action conducted under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA). Design, construct, operate, monitor effectiveness, optimize, and maintain a hydraulic containment system to prevent to the maximum extent practicable, further migration of the chlorinated solvent contaminated groundwater plume beyond Seaway Boulevard. Reduce to the maximum extent practicable, chlorinated solvent contaminated groundwater migration to Powder Mill Creek, south of Seaway Boulevard.

Proponent: The Boeing Company

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: This interim action will be conducted on property owned by the Boeing Company, 3003 West Casino Road, Everett, Washington 98203. Specifically work will occur within Powder Mill Gulch, south of Seaway Boulevard.

Lead agency: Washington State Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
