Dear Mr. Brockman:

Ecology finds the Notice of Construction application you recently submitted complete. Your notice meets the requirements in Washington Administrative Code (WAC) Chapters 173-400 and 173-460. Enclosed is a copy of the anticipated ORDER to authorize you to proceed with the proposed project.

Your project involves the installation of an emergency use diesel engine. The "emergency use" designation of the engine is a voluntary restriction (WAC 173-400-091). This restriction will avoid permitting provisions for new sources that exceed criteria pollutant emission thresholds and exemptible emissions of WAC 173-400. Before we approve your Application, we will hold a 30-day public notice and comment period as required by WAC 173-400-171(2)(a)(x). The public comment period will start August 18, 2008.
