

Remedial Investigation Data Workshop

The Department of Ecology Nuclear Waste Program invites you to attend a workshop to review the data from a remedial investigation at the US Ecology site 23 miles north of Richland near the center of the Hanford Site.

The workshop will start at 9:00 am on Tuesday, April 21, at Ecology's Nuclear Waste Program office – 3100 Port of Benton Blvd, Richland WA 99354.

This workshop will present the data the remedial investigation has collected. Experts who collected and validated the data will be available. The validated data are available at <http://www.ecy.wa.gov/programs/nwp>

US Ecology is a commercial low-level radioactive waste (LLRW) site on 100 acres of federal land near the center of the 586-square-mile federal Hanford Site. US Ecology began operations in 1965. Previous studies have found contamination in soil and groundwater at the LLRW site. Under an Agreed Order, US Ecology will complete the site characterization required by a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study.

The workshop is open to the public.
