Gap Elimination Project; Wetlands, Lynden, Whatcom County, Washington**

Dear Mr. Sandal:

On April 18, 2016, you submitted a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the Riverview Road Gap Elimination project.

The proposed project entails:

- Constructing a new road bed and paving 900 linear feet of existing gravel road to extend River Road from 6th Street (west side of project) to Hannegan Road (east side).
- Creating a 10-foot-wide trail on the south side of the road.
- Constructing a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the north side of the road.
- Improving stormwater management along the road.
- Replanting of temporarily cleared areas.

The project is located at Riverview Road from Hannegan Road to just east of South 6th Street, Lynden, Whatcom County, Washington, Wetland and drains to Nooksack River, SW Section 20, T. 40 N., R. 3E., WRIA 1.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with your determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:



- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
