On July 29, 2005 the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued a water quality certification to Cape George Colony Club for the above-referenced project pursuant to the provisions of 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401).

Ecology received a letter dated November 1, 2010 requesting Ecology amend water quality certification Order No. 2521 to extend the term of the certificate for two (2) additional years.

No other changes in the water quality certification are necessary.

Order No.2521 dated July 29, 2005, is hereby amended as follows:

Condition 5 currently reads:

This water quality certificate shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years from date of issuance.

Condition 5 is amended to read:

This water quality certificate shall remain in effect for a period of seven (7) years from date of issuance.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
