
Dear Mr. Lemmons:

As requested on February 1, 2011, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) is amending the above-referenced Administrative Order.

This amendment is issued under the provisions of Chapter 90.48 RCW and Chapter 173-201A WAC.

Administrative Order #6094 is hereby amended as follows:

1. The first sentence of the fourth paragraph of the project description that reads:

The proposed project will fill 9.8 acres of degraded, low functioning wetlands including an L-shaped stormwater pond.

Is amended to read:

The proposed project will fill a total of 10.0 acres of degraded, low functioning wetlands including and L-shaped stormwater pond.

2. The following sentence is added to the end of the fifth paragraph:

Two sediment collecting wood structures will be added along the margins of the Coweeman River for habitat structure and sediment recruitment.

No other conditions or requirements of the above-mentioned Order are affected by this Amendment. The Department of Ecology retains continuing jurisdiction to make modifications hereto through supplemental order, if it appears necessary to further protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this amendment may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this amendment.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.

Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
