The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has received the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' letter dated August 21, 2012, re-verifying Nationwide Permit (NWP) # 43 for this project under the 2012 Nationwide Permit Program.

Based on this information, Ecology has determined that the project meets the 2012 Washington State 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) conditions for NWP 43. Therefore, an Individual 401 Certification will not be required for this project and you may proceed as directed by the Corps.

In light of the re-verification and the determination that the project meets the 2012 WQC conditions for NWP 43, Ecology hereby rescinds Order No. 9144 that was issued for this project on May 21, 2012.

Any changes to your project that would impact water quality should be submitted in writing to Ecology before work begins for additional review.
