Dear Ms. Walker:

Pursuant to 15 CFR § 930.60, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) and the Lake Stevens Sewer District are writing to advise you of the status of Ecology's review of the project's Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management (CZM) Program.

The Lake Stevens Sewer District filed their application with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) and Ecology. Public notice on the application was issued on April 23, 2007. Ecology received the CZM statement from the Lake Stevens Sewer District on April 24, 2007. The statutory six-month review period commenced to run and will expire October 24, 2007. At this time, Ecology has notified the subject party that CZM Consistency can not be granted until a shoreline permit for the lift station has been issued. The applicant does not have sufficient time to obtain a shoreline permit for the lift station before our six-month deadline.

Ecology and the Lake Stevens Sewer District have agreed to extend the CZM review period until Ecology can issue CZM Consistency.
