This letter is in response to your January 22, 2007 request to amend the above-referenced administrative order issued by the Department of Ecology (Ecology) on June 7, 2006. That administrative order authorizes the Department of Transportation to conduct work in Moses Lake during an established time period of August 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006.

You have requested that the administrative order be amended by changing the established time period from August 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006 to a time period of August 1, 2006 to February 28, 2007.

By this attached order, Ecology amends the original administrative order to authorize the Department of Transportation to conduct work in Moses Lake between the dates of August 1, 2006 to February 28, 2007. This amendment is issued under the provisions of Chapter 90.48 RCW and Chapter 173-201A WAC.

Administrative Order No. 3305 is hereby amended:

The amendment is as follows:

The conditions that reads:

“B.2.a. The short term modification is granted for the duration of 1 day for introduction of Stream C into the newly constructed channel and from August 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006 for pile driving.”

Is replaced as follows:

“B.2.a. The short term modification is granted for the duration of 1 day for introduction of Stream C into the newly constructed channel and from August 1, 2006 to February 28, 2007 for pile driving.”

No other conditions or requirements of the above-mentioned order are affected by this amendment.

The Department of Ecology retains jurisdiction to make modifications through supplemental orders, where necessary to protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this Order.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may obtain review by appeal. The Applicant can appeal up to 30 days after receipt of the permit, and all others can appeal up to 30 days from the postmarked date of the permit. The appeal must be sent to the Washington Pollution Control Hearings Board, P.O. Box 40903, Olympia WA 98504-0903. Concurrently, a copy of the

appeal must be sent to the Department of Ecology, Shorelands and Environmental Assistance Program, P.O. Box 47600, Olympia WA 98504-7600. These procedures are consistent with the provisions of Chapter 43.21B RCW and the implementing rules and regulations.
