This amendment is to the above-referenced Administrative Order approved and issued by the Department of Ecology on March 30, 2007.


This amendment is issued under the provisions of Chapter 90.48 RCW and Chapter 173-201A WAC.

Administrative Order No. 4097 is hereby amended as follows:

**Original project:** The project approved under Department of Ecology Water Quality Certification Order No. 4097 issued March 30, 2007, included restoring temporarily impacted wetlands; removing culverts; and creating, rehabilitating and enhancing forested wetland as mitigation. The mitigation was to be completed as soon as practicable, no later than June 1, 2007. Submittal of a Record Report and documentation showing the means of permanent protection for the mitigation sites was required within 60 days of completing construction, and in no case later than July 31, 2007.

**Revised project:** By this Order, the Department of Ecology amends the timing of the mitigation work from the original Certification to be completed as soon as practicable, no later than October 1, 2007. The Record Report and documentation showing the means of permanent protection for the mitigation sites shall be submitted within 60 days of completing construction, and in no case later than December 1, 2007.
