This amendment is issued under the provisions of Chapter 90.48 RCW and Chapter 173-201A WAC.

Administrative Order No. 1998-4-00422 is hereby amended:

The amendment is as follows

The conditions that reads:

- B.4 The short term modification is granted for a total of 10 working days occurring during the month of February.

Is replaced as follows:

- B.4 The short term modification is granted for a total of 10 working days occurring during the month of July.

No other conditions or requirements of the above-mentioned Order are affected by this amendment.

The Department of Ecology retains continuing jurisdiction to make modifications hereto through supplemental order, if it appears necessary to further protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this Order.

Any person aggrieved by this Order may obtain review through appeal. The Applicant can appeal up to 30 days after receipt of the permit, and all others can appeal up to 30 days from the postmarked date of the permit. The appeal must be sent to the Washington Pollution Control Hearings Board, P.O. Box 40903, Olympia WA 98504-0903. Concurrently, a copy of the appeal must be sent to the Department of Ecology, Shorelands and Environmental Assistance Program, P.O. Box 47600, Olympia WA 98504-7600. These procedures are consistent with the provisions of Chapter 43.21B RCW and its implementing rules and regulations.
