On November 16, 2011 the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued a water quality certification to Longview Fibre Paper and Packaging for the above-referenced project pursuant to the provisions of 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401).

Ecology received an e-mail dated November 30, 2011 requesting that Ecology amend water quality certification Order No. 8866 to include the proposed mitigation for the project.

No other changes in the water quality certification are necessary.

Order No.8866 dated November 16, 2011, is hereby amended as follows:

The following sentence in the project description:

The purpose of this project is to maintain navigable depths for shipping vessels using Longview Fibre docking facilities.

Is replaced with:

The purpose of this project is to maintain navigable depths for shipping vessels using Longview Fibre docking facilities. The Applicant is also purposing to provide funding to the Lower Columbia Fish Enhancement Group ("LCFEG") as mitigation for the dredging activities. The mitigation project will benefit Chinook, Coho, and steelhead, which are the same species as those to be impacted by dredging. The Applicant will provide funding for one large woody material structure for the LCFEG project that is currently under construction in the South Fork Toutle River.

All other sections of the current 401 water quality certificate remain unchanged.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:


- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
