ERRATUM/REVISION: This erratum corrects the Corps/Ecology Joint Public Notice dated 3 February 2009.

The corrected information is as follows:

Dredged Material Testing: The proposed dredged material has been tested according to the procedures specified in PSDDA, a multi-agency program for the evaluation of dredged material proposed for disposal at open-water sites in Puget Sound. The PSDDA evaluations may include both chemical and biological testing of sediments. For this project, the PSDDA agencies determined that all 3,000 cubic yards of sediment is **unsuitable** for open-water disposal. Therefore, the dredged material will be deposited at an upland site, approved by the Washington State Department of Ecology and the King County Department of Health. The sediment testing data are available at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Seattle District, Dredged Material Management Office.

All other information shown on Public Notice NWS-2008-1496 remains unchanged.
