Two Applications for State of Washington Water Quality Certification and Coastal Zone Management Act Consistency

Interested parties are hereby notified that the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has received an application to perform work in waters of the United States as described below and shown on the enclosed drawings.

Ecology will review the work pursuant to Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, with applicable provisions of State water pollution control laws and the Coastal Zone Management Act.

This public notice is consistent with the requirements of Section 401 of the federal Clean Water Act and Chapter 173-225 of Washington Administrative Code. This notice is only intended to inform all interested parties of the proposed projects and to seek comments from the public, local, state, federal, and tribal agencies. It does not indicate approval of the proposed projects by any state agency.

Comment and Review Period

Ecology is requesting comments from the public, state and local agencies, tribes, and other interested parties to evaluate the impacts of each proposed activity.

Anyone wanting to present their views about either of these projects may do so by providing written comments within comment period of this publication. Conventional mail or e-mail comments on this public notice will be accepted and made part of the record.

Ecology will evaluate all the comments received to determine whether to approve, approve with conditions, or deny a certification for the proposed work.

Location

SR 105 between mile post 9.97 and 10.74, about 10 miles northwest of Raymond in Pacific County.

Work

This project will replace the North River & Smith Creek bridges. Including highway and access road realignments, road prism construction, ground improvement, temporary detour bridge construction at Smith Creek, temporary over-water work platform construction for both bridges, and log boom removal in North River.

Project Number 2:

US 101 Bone River Bridge Replacement

Location

US 101 milepost 45.08 to 45.32, just south of South Bend in Pacific County.

Work

This project will replace Bone River Bridge in its current location. Also included in the project are ground improvement, temporary detour bridge construction, and temporary over-water work platform construction. Demolition of the detour bridge, temporary work platforms, and existing bridge will also be necessary.
