

## Aquaculture Licensure Collaboration Meetings

### What was the purpose of meetings?

To discuss what information each agency is collecting and how it might be shared in the future.

### What has been discussed?

- What type of data is being collected by each agency?
  - WDFW – Aquatic Farm Registration Application –(No Fee) data description
    - Name of Applicant or Business name
    - Address
    - Property owned/leased
    - Species Cultured
    - Culture Use-Inter-tidal, Sub-tidal, hatchery etc-fin fish info
    - Aquatic District Number
    - Bay/Inlet
    - Parcel Number
    - Section, Township, Range
  - WDFW collecting data of managed acres & actual cultivated acres on Aquatic Farm Registration (AFR) Application.
    - Identify what is being harvested from Quarterly Reports that are submitted
  - DOH – Harvest Site Application (Fee based on # of Harvest sites & License category)– data description
    - Licensed Applicant Name
    - Company name
    - Address
    - Harvest Site Owner
    - Harvest Site Address
    - Parcel Number
    - Species to be harvested
    - Section, Township, Range
    - Lease Agreement
    - Copy of Tax Statement
    - County Parcel Map

Highlights indicates duplication.

- DOH records data that is submitted on the HSC.

NOTE: It was acknowledged that there is a lot of information/data that multiple agencies are requiring and tracking.

- Ecology receives- Joint Aquatic Resource Permit Application-JARPA- for any project that needs a Water Quality Certification. In addition to JARPA Ecology has a Supplemental form for Nationwide Permit 48
  - Species- Geoduck Aquaculture
  - Name –Property owner
- Current ways data is collection and stored (database or hard file)?
  - DOH – SQL Server – (Microsoft application) – in process of updating to a newer version.
    - Mapping on GIS-old technology
  - WDFW – SQL Server – (Power Builder) in the process of building a new system.
    - No GIS for mapping AFR info
  - Ecology - SQL Server- will be updating or building a new system.
    - Mapping on GIS

**NOTE: Currently none of the Agencies databases can exchange information.**

#### Next steps:

- Continue to review data by agency level ad hoc team to determine if one system can be developed to meet all of the agencies needs.
- Discuss modification to current business process to share information between agencies for prevention of duplication of efforts (i.e. if 1<sup>st</sup> stop is WDFW AFR information DOH can obtain this through access data sharing or if DOH is 1<sup>st</sup> DOH shares data will WDFW & DOE).
- Agencies to explore future funding support for IT support and modification to current business processes to share information - Work with SARC to prepare Legislative Budget Package
