Implementation of revised Spokane County Shoreline Master Program will improve water quality and appreciate comments in support of program and its implementation. Comments specific to discharge of gray water in Clallam County should be forwarded to DOE and Clallam County staff for review and a separate response.
2	Supportive comment	Ellen Picken	Supports the regulations, and is concerned about water quality.	Implementation of revised Spokane County Shoreline Master Program will improve existing conditions in shoreline jurisdiction countywide including the Spokane River.
3	Connection to public sewer system	Kottayam V. Natarajan Jr.	Believes any new residential development should connect to public sewer system, regardless of location of urban growth area boundary.	Implementation of revised Spokane County Shoreline Master Program applicable countywide and provision of public sewer service is precluded in rural areas outside the established Urban Growth Area Boundary. Residential development outside the Urban Growth Area is rural in character and density and is subject to revised regulations to protect ground water.
