



Shoreline Environment Designations

- Notes:
1. Areas waterward of the OHMM are designated Aquatic.
 2. The OHMM of the Pacific Ocean, as defined as the winter edge of vegetation, shall be the start of the landward shoreline jurisdiction for the City. The City will work with Ecology to make a field determination of the OHMM of the Pacific Ocean for individual developments.
 3. The City's shoreline jurisdiction for the Pacific Ocean goes out to the three-mile limit.
 4. The City's shoreline jurisdiction extends to the middle of the channel.
 5. The City's shoreline jurisdiction extends to the middle of Grays Harbor.
